Gentlemen:

You have made a believer out of me. As a certified diesel mechanic, owner and operator of a 2000 Western Star 4964 EX with an N14 Cummins. I have come across several fuel additives claiming to improve fuel performance and until now, none of them worked. Based on a success claim from a fellow truck operator I decided to give, FPC a try.

My truck has an on board computer that provides a constant reading on my fuel consumption. After adding FPC to my fuel, I observed an almost immediate improvement in my mileage. I stopped using the additive and my mileage dropped right back to prior levels. When I resumed using FPC my mileage again improved as it did the first time.

Based on dozens of tanks of fuel, over a number of weeks, I am fully confident that FPC has improved my mileage by a minimum of 6% and up to 9%.
