Dear Howie Damron,

This letter is to update you on what FPC is doing for our School System after a year of introducing your product to our fuel tanks.

For the past few years our fuel budget has been depleted before the end of each school year due to the rising cost of fuel. After seeing the results from the test performed on 8 of our School Systems buses indicating that the fuel mileage increased an average of one mile per gallon (10-12%). I also tested my personal vehicle and several of my friend's vehicles coming up with the same results.

My goal as Fleet Manager was to use FPC in my entire Fleet and have funds left in the fuel budget at the end of the 06-07 school year. I am very excited to say that goal was accomplished.

We also had to start using Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel in our buses this year. Due to the lack of lubricity in the new fuel a large part of the school systems in Georgia experienced fuel related problems in their buses costing them unexpected money for repairs. We experienced some of the same problems but not as severe as some of the other systems. I believe this is due to the addition of FPC in our fuel.
